

# Aspic 003 Coffee Table

Technical Information



Poured concrete is formed into a family of a dining table and coffee tables in three sizes with sinuous shapes and a refined terrazzo finish of the tabletops. Tops can be round or oval, resting on solid vertical walls that give the base characterful concave volumes. The low tables are made in a stylish, versatile grey colour, while the dining table also comes in a choice of orange and green finishes, as well as a mole coloured variant. In the presence of moisture, the traditional cement used for ASPIC side tables may develop efflorescence, a surface deposit of saltpetre caused by a natural chemical reaction. This is a normal phenomenon that does not affect the quality, durability, or long-term appearance of the product. Efflorescence may appear mainly at the junction between the top and the base and can be easily removed with a dry cloth, fine-grit sandpaper, or specific cement cleaning products.

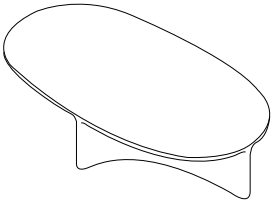


