

# Erice 001 Armchair (Stackable)

Technical Information



ERICE is a small medieval village located in Sicily, known for a particular textile art that finds its origins in the ancient influences of Greece and the Middle East. The famous ERICE rugs are handcrafted by skilled women who weave strips of scrap fabrics on a series of parallel threads on a loom. With the same spirit, ERICE is a seat designed with the intent to optimize manual work and the use of textile material, while at the same time providing an object with a strong decorative impact. The structure made of aluminum tubes and belts becomes a real frame that guides the weaving operations. Passing through the holes created by laser cutting, the belts draw a geometric pattern made of color blocks that alternate, creating different patterns depending on the point of view of the chair.

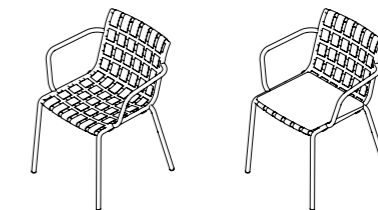

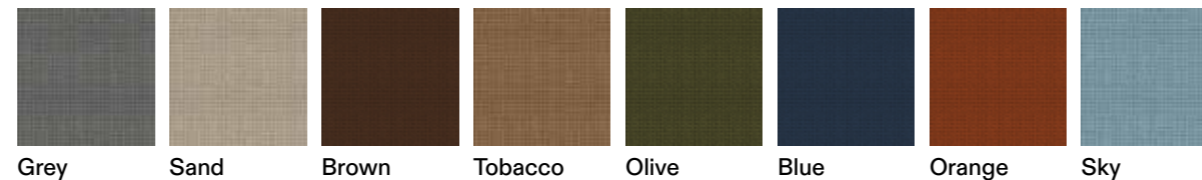
